(A) Tell us what makes your student job extraordinary (max. 1,000 characters incl. spaces):

Since my first year of university at Politecnico di Milano I have been a part of the fire brigade of my County. Being a fireman is, sometimes, really difficult, especially because at the same time I follow my courses in Aerospace Engineering. My job, I would rather call it art, consists in working turnover of 12 hours each, during the day and the night. We stayed out all the whole night, and going to the university and following the lessons of the day after was a real challenge, but there are two things that gave and still gives me the power to go ahead: the PASSION for what I do, that helps me every time I am really tired and the interest of the people when they are surprised knowing that during this years I have been working, becoming amazing when they realise that my job is being a Fireman.
